

- Five-minute online survey
- Quarterly tracking
- Sample via EWS Online Research Panel



# **POPULATION:**

- 450 interviews per quarter
- Mobile Majority ages 18-72, determined by U.S. Census data



# **QUALIFYING CRITERIA**


- Ages 18 72 | HS diploma or higher |
  Mix of race, gender, age, employment |
  Standard criteria excludes unemployed
  – for this study, temporarily
  unemployed due to crisis are included
- Not employed in a sensitive industry
- Must own a smartphone and have a checking or savings account




### MOST RESPONDENTS ARE BECOMING MORE COMFORTABLE WITH DOMESTIC TRAVEL

Will you be traveling outside of the United States by the end of 2021?


